

BOARD MEMBER CONFLICT OF INTEREST

A School Board member shall not perform any labor, or furnish equipment or supplies for compensation. He/She shall not be interested directly in any contract with the School District which may have remunerative awards to the School Board member.

No School Board member may participate in discussing or vote on any issue in which the member has a conflict of interest. Each School Board member shall decide if any potential conflict of interest requires such member to be disqualified from participating in discussion or voting.

However, no School Board member may participate in discussing or vote on an issue if the following circumstances apply:

- The School Board member has a direct pecuniary interest in the matter before the School Board; or
- At least two-thirds of the School Board votes that a member has an identifiable conflict of interest that should prohibit the member from voting on a specific matter.

Each School Board member shall annually sign an acknowledgment of a conflict of interest policy, and update as necessary.
