

BOARD-SUPERINTENDENT/ CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RELATIONSHIP

The Board believes that the legislation of policies is its most important function and that execution of those policies is the function of the superintendent/chief executive officer (CEO). Together, the Board and the superintendent/chief executive officer (CEO) are a team, each playing a well-defined position.

The superintendent/CEO will be the chief executive officer of the Board and will be responsible for the administrative and advisory functions of the Board. Planning, policy making and evaluation are the functions of the Board.

The Board holds the superintendent/chief executive officer (CEO) responsible for the administration of its policies, the execution of Board decisions, the operation of internal machinery designed to serve the school program, and for keeping the Board informed about school operations and problems.
