

STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The rights and responsibilities of students in the public schools of the district include:

1. Civil rights - including the right to equal educational opportunity and freedom from discrimination; the responsibility not to discriminate against others.
2. The right to attend free public schools; the responsibility to attend school regularly and to observe school rules essential for permitting others to learn at school.
3. The right to due process of law with respect to suspension and expulsion; the responsibility to follow school rules and policies.
4. The right to privacy, which includes privacy in respect to the student's records consistent with state and federal law.
