

## **Montrose Elementary School Supply List 2017-2018**

**JK/Kindergarten:** Large backpack, (1) 1” 3-ring binder, Facial Tissue (200 Count), (1) vinyl 2-pocket folder-No 3 prong folders please, Hard case plastic pencil box, 1 spiral notebook, 1 activity/coloring book, Glue sticks, Crayons (one box per semester), Elmer’s glue, Pencils, Eraser (soft pink or green), Fiskar scissors, Towel for rest time-no mats please, Headphones in a Ziploc bag, Gym shoes to be kept at school.

**Grade 1:** Grade 1: (3) two pocket folders; (1) 3 prong folder; 4 regular wide-lined spiral notebooks; 3-ring binder (no larger than 1”); headphones in a ziplock bag; regular sticky notes; 6 dry erase markers; storage box with lid (shoebox size); bookbag The following items will be shared as community supplies: 12 pencils, 2 boxes of 16-24 crayons, bottle of white glue, scissors (pointed), 2 erasers (soft pink or green); box of 8 markers; large box of kleenex

**Grade 2:** \*\*Community Supplies – 12 yellow pencils, box 16-24 crayons, 2 bottles of glue, 1 package of soft pink/green erasers, sticky notes, 1 box (8) markers, dry erase markers, Clorox wipes, 1 box of Kleenex, highlighter – \*\* Please do not label these items with your child’s name – these will be supplies that are available for all students to use.

\*\* Individual Supplies – 1 (shoe box sized) plastic container, (1) 1-inch binder, (1) 3-prong folder, (2) 3-hole punched folders, (2) regular folders, (3) regular wide ruled spiral notebooks, (1) dry eraser (old sock is fine), headphones in a Ziploc baggie, colored pencils, scissors \*\*These items will be kept in their plastic container. Gym shoes that are to be kept at school

**Grade 3:** (12) #2 pencils, a large eraser; pencil box; colored pencils; washable markers; highlighter; ruler with inches and centimeters; Elmer’s glue bottle and glue stick; scissors, (2) large boxes of Kleenex; (2) wide-rule notebooks, (2) two-pocket folders; pencil eraser tops; & headphones in a Ziploc bag (1) black composition notebook; & (3) dry-erase markers; 1 one inch binder.

**Grade 4:** Eraser; crayons; colored pencils; washable markers; yellow highlighter; 12 #2 pencils; Pencil top erasers, 2 red pens; ruler with inches and centimeters; scissors; 2-two pocket folders; package of loose leaf wide rule paper; 2 one-inch binders, 2 **composition** notebooks (1 regular and one grid paper); 2 large box of Kleenex; bottle glue & glue stick; small sticky notes (one pad at a time); 8 dry-erase markers; & headphones in a Ziploc bag.

**Grade 5:** 6 composition notebooks (7”x 10”), 1 spiral notebook or loose paper, 3 soft side 3 ring binders, Pencil Pack, Large Eraser, Scissors, Liquid glue, Ruler, Colored Pencils, Markers, Crayons optional, rubber cement, pencil box or bag, black sharpie or similar black marker, 3 different colored highlighters, 1 dry erase marker, & headphones in a Ziploc bag.

**\*Grades that are required to bring notebooks should not bring Trapper Keepers. All backpacks must be able to fit in student’s locker.**

**\*All grade school students must have a pair of shoes to be worn only in the gym during PE class. These may be older tennis shoes that are clean.**

## MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL

### School Supply List for 2017-2018

#### Middle School General Supply

Stylus, Headphones, Highlighters, Black Sharpie, Pencils, Pens, Colored Pencils, Scissors, Glue, Markers, Erasers, Ruler, Pencil box/pencil bag (big enough to carry calculator), pack of 3 Kleenex boxes, 2 dry erase markers

**Science (Green)** – (1) green notebook, 1 green folder.

**Math** - scientific calculator, graph composition notebook

**Reading (Red)** – 4 red notebooks, 1 red folder,

**Language Arts (Blue)** - 4 blue notebooks, 1 blue folder

**Social Studies (Yellow)** – 1 yellow XL book cover/paper bag, 1 yellow folder

**Exploratory**—1/2 yard 100% cotton material (don't need until 4<sup>th</sup> quarter)

#### High School (grades 9-12)

**General Supplies** – Stylus, Ear phones or ear buds for computer use, highlighters, colored pencils, Kleenex, pencils, pens, scissors, markers, erasers, & a ruler. **(The school will provide computer laptop sleeves that the computers WILL BE kept in.)** Glue

**Algebra I** – spiral notebook for math notes, scientific calculator

**Pre-Algebra**– spiral notebook for math notes, scientific calculator

**Geometry**– spiral notebook for math notes, scientific calculator, compass, protractor

**Algebra 2**– spiral notebook for math notes, scientific calculator, compass, protractor

**Trig**– spiral notebook for math notes, scientific calculator (graphing calculator – optional but recommended TI-83 or TI 84), compass, protractor, ruler and dry erase marker.

**Pre-calc**– spiral notebook for math notes, scientific calculator (graphing calculator - optional but recommended TI 83 or TI 84), compass, protractor, ruler and dry erase marker

**English I/Literature** – spiral bound notebook for journals, folder for English I/Literature materials, flash drive for saving and transferring documents and projects, 1 inch binder for grammar resource book.

**English II/Speech** – spiral bound notebook for journals, folder for English II/Speech materials, 3x5 or 4x6 lined note cards for speeches, flash drive for saving and transferring documents and projects

**English III/American Literature** - spiral bound notebook for journals, folder for English III/American Literature materials, flash drive for saving and transferring documents and projects

**English IV/World Literature** – spiral bound notebook for journals, folder for English IV/Literature materials, flash drive for saving and transferring documents and projects. 1 inch binder for senior portfolio.

**Science (all classes)** – notebook & folder, calculator, colored pencils, scissors, glue, post it tabs

**PE & Weight Training** – t-shirt, shorts, towel, non-mark gym shoes

**Basic Carpentry**—each student is **required** to provide wood needed to build three separate projects and they are **required** to provide a project that needs to be refinished (ex. dining room table or a dresser)

**Band** – Black Speedsters marching shoes (purchased through school), black socks, formal concert attire (button-up shirt/tie with dress pants and shoes for boys, skirt and dressy blouse within dress code or full length dress, or dress pants, and dress shoes, not flip-flops for girls) reeds, valve oil, or drumsticks (two sets Ralph Hardimon Corpmaster sticks for snare players, tenor mallets for quads, bass drum mallets for bass drum players, and a set of Vic Firth SD1 general sticks for concert playing), small stick bag for drummers. Pencils

**Choir** – dress pants (Khakis or dress slacks), dress shirt (polo, button-down, nice blouse), dress shoes (black or brown shoes, no flip flops or sneakers) pencils

**Video Editing**—SD card 2GB or bigger
